Dear Resident:

The members of the Treasure Coast Crime Prevention Association and the Martin, and St. Lucie County Emergency Management Department have joined together for your protection. We are concerned about the safety of your life and property in a time of a hurricane or any other natural disaster. That is why we have developed the "Treasure Coast Disaster Re-Entry Program."

This program will alleviate confusion when there is an evacuation ordered for the barrier Islands of Martin and St. Lucie counties. Also, it will aid in the protection of your property by keeping looters from coming into the evacuated area. To receive a placard, each resident **MUST** produce proof that they reside on the barrier islands, such as a recent utility bill with a local address along with a local driver's license. **A DRIVER'S LICENSE ITSELF WILL NOT BE SUFFICIENT.** We will give one placard for each household of residents of the barrier island of St. Lucie and Martin counties. **The placard is for emergency use only as is not a mandatory program to get back onto the Barrier Islands; it is designed to help with traffic flow and to work as a deterrent against looting.**
